My five favorite jewelry


And of all the films? I will not hide my preferences. Here is a short list my five favorite jewelry die. Five jewels to remember.

- 1) Chantal (necklace) by Tina Lattarulo (Italian painter and sculptor). Chantal has six strings of pearls of different lengths that meet three silver wings. The symbol of the wings is also the logo and signature of Alas Art. It combines elegance and refinement.
- 2) Death of the coral reefs (Necklace) of Sihua Ariel Chen (Singapore fashion designer). It is an adjustable necklace. Silvery crystals pointy end that symbolically represent the reefs destroyed by oil. A strong ecological message. A beautiful line and great achievement.
- 3) Rubber Soul (Necklace) of Liisa Gude Deberitz (Norwegian jewelery artist). Handmade and realized with silver and rubber. Really unique. Charming.

- 4) Lace Ring (Ring) The Gabrielle Friedman (Nashville, United States). Realiazzato with a particular technique, with dripping wax and then melted in 10K gold with a diamond stone of three millimeters set in one of the rings. Each piece is unique. It is close to perfection. Very beautifull.
- 5) **Nodes** (Necklace) of **Simona Girelli** (Italian designer). It is not a simple necklace. but a real sculpture. Magic and elegant necklace made of thick chain of polystyrene rings purple. And 'one piece. Wear it.

I assure you it was not easy to locate only five jewels. Jewelry? But what I say. They are little masterpieces to be admired in the volume **Artistar Jewels**, an annual publication that promotes contemporary jewelery internationally.


